#### Station 201

Station 201 serves the west side of Grove City, and crews at this station were the first to respond to a propane explosion at a nearby Ferrellgas plant. Jackson Township's Tanglebrook Park sits behind this station.

The Jackson Township Fire Department was established in 1945 and has a total of 104 members. The staff is made up of 25, part-time and 79, full-time employees. The department responds to approximately 1,656 fires per year, 6,850 EMS calls and 3,847 other calls. It is a combined department consisting of four stations.

The department's equipment consists of 2 Pumpers, 1 Ladder, 2 Rescue Engines, 4 Ambulances and 1 boat.

#### Station 203

Station 203 is off London-Groveport Road in Grove City and houses the HazMat Unit, rescue engine and is the oldest active station. Crews at Station 203 frequently provide mutual aid for surrounding Hamilton, Harrison, Pleasant and Scioto townships and respond to numerous high-speed auto accidents off Interstate 71 which runs from Cleveland to Cincinnati.

### Station 202

Jackson Township Division of Fire Headquarters is at Station 202 which is home to Ladder 202 and Boat 202. The station's "silo-like" architecture is a tribute to the property it sits on which used to be the Ziner family farm.

#### Station 204

Jackson Township's newest fire station, expected to open spring 2014, was fully funded by tax increment financing from The City of Grove City and federal grant money.
