The Jackson Township Board of Trustees met in the Township Administration Building, 3756 Hoover Road, Grove City, Ohio, for Special Meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Monday April 23, 2018. Present were Trustees Burris, Bowshier and Rauck, Fiscal Officer Ron Grossman and Fire Chief Randy Little.

NEW BUSINESS

RESOLUTION 2018-034

Mr. Burris read resolution 2018-034 and moved to sell vacant property. Mr. Bowshier seconded the motion. VOTE: all yes.

Trustees discussed the property damage on S.R. 665 from the fire department engine. Chief Little will address the driving problem. Road department will fix the rut.

Mr. Bowshier announced that he would like to renew our ad with Grove City Chamber for 2 years and asked for approval from the trustees. PayCor is increasing their service charges by 7% starting May 1st 2018.

At 4:15 p.m., Mr. Bowshier moved to go into executive session to consider the discipline of a public employee as set forth in Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G). Mr. Rauck seconded the motion. VOTE: all yes.

Mr. Bowshier announced he wishes to stop being acting administrator.


At 4:55 p.m., Mr. Bowshier moved to go out of executive session. Mr. Rauck seconded the motion. VOTE: all yes.
