NOTICE TO BIDDERS The Trustees of Jackson Township (Franklin County, OH) will receive sealed bids postmarked on or before March 19, 2019 at 12:30 PM EST, for performing all the labor and supplying all material necessary for the demolition, excavation and re-construction of concrete driveway for rear of Fire Station #202 located at 3650 Hoover Road, Grove City. Sealed bids shall be mailed to "Jackson Township - Concrete Rear Replacement Project", c/o Ron Grossman, Fiscal Officer, 3756 Hoover Road, P.O. Box 517, Grove City, OH 43123.

Awarded bid shall be announced at the Trustee Meeting, at 7:00 PM EST, April 2, 2019, at the Township Office, 3756 Hoover Road, Grove City, OH 43123.

Estimate of Cost - \$120,000. A Pre-Bid Meeting will be by appointment only. Please contact Rex Blair (614) 565-6148 to discuss and review the project requirements. Each bid shall be in conformity with the Ohio Revised Code, shall contain the names of every person and company interested therein, and shall be on Proposal forms included in the specification. Each Proposal shall be accompanied by a 100% Bid Guaranty Bond, or a Bid Guaranty pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 153.54 in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 1305, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid. If the bid guaranty is a bid bond, such bond shall provide that, if the bid is accepted, the bidder will enter into a proper contract in accordance with the bid and the plans and specifications. The bid bond shall further be conditioned to indemnify the Township against all damage suffered by failure to perform the contract in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 153.54, and will be in the proper form in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 153.57. If the bid guaranty is a certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 1305,

the bidder will, after the award of the contract, enter into a proper contract in accordance with the bid and the plans and specifications, or become liable to the Township for the difference between its bid and that of the next lowest bidder. See Ohio Revised Code §153.54.

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# GENERAL INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### INTERPRETATION OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

If any person, firm or corporation contemplating the submission of a proposal for this Contract is in doubt as to the true meaning of any part of the Drawings, Specifications or other Contract Documents, he may submit to the Township a written request for an interpretation thereof. The person, firm or corporation submitting the request shall be responsible for its prompt delivery. Such interpretation will be made only by a Memorandum duly issued by the designer and a copy of such Memorandum will be mailed or delivered to each person securing a set of the Contract Documents, provided that sufficient period of time is available for the issuance and the delivery of such Memorandum prior to the receipt of the bids. The Owner and the Designer will not be responsible for any other explanations of the Contract Documents made prior to the receipt of bids.

### PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS

The Supplemental Specifications included herein are specifically applicable to this improvement, previous customs or practices to the contrary, notwithstanding. In case there is any actual or apparent discrepancy or conflict between the Supplemental Specifications and other specifications or provisions contained herein, the former shall take precedence and govern the work of the Contractor.

### PROPOSAL & SEALED BID

All blank spaces in the Proposal shall be properly filled in and completed. No additional or qualifying clauses shall be written into any clause or requirement. The price bid for labor and the price for material shall be stated separately for each item (mandatory under the law); also the Total Price, in figures, (the sum of the separate prices bid for labor and material) shall be stated for each item. The "Proposal, Contract Documents and Specifications" must be submitted IN THEIR ENTIRETY in a SEALED ENVELOPE.

### AWARD OF CONTACT

The Contract will, if let, be awarded to the Lowest, Best and Most Responsive Bidder. In determining the lowest and most responsive bid, the following elements shall be considered: Whether the bidder involved: (a) maintains a permanent place of business; (b) has adequate equipment and facilities to dot the work properly and expeditiously; (c) has a suitable financial status to meet obligations incident to the work; (d) has appropriate technical experience and expertise; (e) is an experienced Bidder, especially involving work similar to that called for; and (f) has displayed acceptable conduct and performance on previous contracts both in terms of workmanship and timeliness of both performance and completion; (g) has completed five similar projects within the past five (5) year, and (h) failure to secure and provide the bonds required shall not be constructed as indisputable evidence that the Bidder meets any of the foregoing requirements.

### STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

The Bidder's particular attention is directed to the Statement of Qualifications for Contractor and Sub-contractor/s. These pages must be properly completed by the Bidder.

### DOMESTIC STEEL REQUIREMENT

Domestic Steel use requirements as specified in Section 153 of the Ohio Revised Code apply to this project.

## INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

### **PROJECT SCHEDULE TO BE PROVIDED & APPROVED**

The Contractor shall submit a Project Schedule for the construction project, for approval by the Township, prior to commencement. The schedule shall be submitted to the Township during the Pre-Construction Meeting for review and approval.

### **PRE-CONSTRUCTION MEETING**

A pre-construction meeting will be held prior to commencement of the work for this improvement at the Jackson Township Hall, 3756 Hoover Road, Jackson Township, Franklin County, Ohio. Representatives from the Township and the contractor including all available sub-contractors along with representatives from any affected utility companies.

### **COMPLETION DATE**

The Contractor shall complete the work within the time limit set forth in the Contract Documents, refer to remedy for liquidated damages in the event that work is not completed as approved.

### **PERMITS**

The Contractor shall obtain ALL necessary permits prior to start of construction.

## **SAFETY & INSURANCE**

### **WORKER'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE**

The Contractor shall take out and maintain, during the life of this Contract, adequate Worker's Compensation Insurance for all his employees employed at the site of the project and, in the event that any work is sublet, the Contractor shall require the Sub-Contractors similarly to provide Worker's Compensation Insurance for the latter's employees, unless such employees are covered by the protection afforded by the Contractor. In case any class of employees engaged in hazardous work under the Contract at the site of the project is not protected under the Worker's Compensation statute, the Contractor shall provide and shall cause each Sub-contractor to provide suitable insurance for the protection of his employees not otherwise protected.

In order to comply with the above requirements, the Contractor shall furnish and attach to each executed copy of the Contract Documents a Worker's Compensation Certificate of Insurance coverage, signed by the Ohio Industrial Commission, showing that the Contractor has paid his Industrial Insurance premiums.

### **AMOUNT OF INSURANCE REQUIRED (Liability & Property)**

The amount to such Public Liability Insurance shall be adequate to provide full coverage for any one accident of not less than \$500,000 for Personal Injury to any one person and a total of not less than \$1,000,000 for personal injury to all persons involved. The amount of such Property Damage Insurance shall be adequate to provide full coverage for any one accident of not less than \$200,000 and a total of not less than \$500,000 for all accidents.

### **OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY & HEALTH ACT**

The Contractor and Sub-contractor/s shall be solely responsible for complying with the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (OSHA) during the conduct and performance on and in connection with this project.

### **EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY**

Contractor must ensure that all employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, Vietnam Era and disabled or of national origin.

## WAGES

### WAGE RATES

The statutory requirements of the State of Ohio regarding prevailing wages shall be in effect. The Contractor and all sub-contractors shall pay employees the prevailing wages established by the Ohio Department of Commerce, including all updates, and shall comply with the provisions of Section 4115 of the Ohio Revised Code. The Prevailing Wage Rate Schedule is attached in the Contract Documents. The agreed upon sum of the contract shall not be enforced because of increases in wage rates. The wage rates in effect at the time the contract was executed shall be prevailing for the duration of the project to contract completion.

### PAYMENT OF WAGE

Applications for Payment shall be made upon evidence of progress in completion of the work described. Each application shall contain enough detail to facilitate accurate and timely payments.

### LICENSING of CORPORATIONS

Particular attention is called to the statutory requirements of the State of Ohio relative to licensing of Corporations organized under the laws of any other state.

### EXTRA COMPENSATION

No extra compensation will be paid the Contractor by reason of compliance with any of the requirements indicated in the Specifications, but payment shall be deemed to be included among the several items as proposed, unless otherwise specifically provided.

### FAILURE TO COMPLETE ON TIME

If the Contractor fails to complete the work within the time or times allowed by the Contract, Jackson Township, Franklin County, Ohio if satisfied that the Contractor is carrying the work forward within reasonable progress, and deems it to be in the best interest of the public, may allow the Contractor to continue in control of the work. It shall be necessary for the Contractor to make written application to Jackson Township, Franklin County, Ohio in order to warrant such continuance. Payments to the Contractor for work performed and materials furnished will be made.

When the work IS NOT completed within the time or times allowed by the Contract and the Contractor is permitted to remain in control, the work shall be prosecuted at as many different places, at such times, and with such forces as Jackson Township, Franklin County, Ohio may require.

For each calendar day that any work shall remain uncompleted after the contract completion date, or dates, the sum specified herein will be deducted from any money due the Contractor, not as a penalty but as Liquidated Damages; provided, however, that due account shall be taken of any adjustment of the completion date or dates granted. In the event a period of liquidated damages for an interim completion date overlaps a subsequent completion date, the higher rate of liquidated damages will apply for the duration of the overlap.

Permitting the Contractor to continue and finish the work or any part of it after the date or dates fixed for its completion, or after the date or dates to which completion may be extended, will in no way

operate as a waiver on the part of Jackson Township, Franklin County, Ohio or any of its rights under the Contract.
