INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING BIDS

1. The original bid response shall be submitted in a sealed envelope with the words **“SCBA Cascade and Fill System”** clearly marked on the outside of the envelope. If bidder is using an alternate or similar type of service, the bid response must be contained in a sealed envelope within the “Express Mailer Package” (the bid description must be listed on the exterior of the sealed envelope contained within the “Express” mailer). **Failure to submit the bid in a sealed envelope and / or without the bid description clearly marked on the exterior shall result in immediate disqualification and no further consideration given for the award.**
2. The original bid response packet (hereinafter referred to as “bid”) shall be submitted to the following:

3. Bid shall be received no later than one (1) hour prior to the scheduled date and time of opening as listed on the Invitation to Bid (hereinafter referred to as “ITB”). All bids will be time and date stamped upon receipt by Jackson Township Division of Fire, which shall be the official date and time of receipt. Postmarks, or other times and dates appearing will not be considered as the official date and time of receipt. Delivery to any other location not defined above, does not constitute a bid received by the Jackson Township Division of Fire. Bids submitted with insufficient postage will not be accepted. Telegraphic, facsimiles, or any other mode of transmission other than stated above shall not be considered as valid submission to the Agency. Bidders using an alternate or similar type of mailing service should verify with the service as to which address is required to ensure proper delivery of the response to Jackson Township Division of Fire. The agency will not be held liable for non-delivery and/or late delivery of any bid response due to a bidder listing an incorrect address.
4. The original bid response shall be properly completed, signed by the bidder and accompanied by one copy of necessary supportive documentation, including the executed non-collusion affidavit. The original bid response must contain an authorized original signature of the bidder on the signature page.
5. Any and all exceptions to the specifications outlined herein shall be noted on the bid specification and thoroughly explained in the bid proposal. It will be the responsibility of the Jackson Township Division of Fire to determine if a substitution to the specification is considered “equal to”. The bidder must provide with any exception detailed specifications so that the Fire Department can make the necessary comparisons to make a proper decision. Failure to do so may result in the rejection of submitted bid for noncompliance.
6. Any bid received after the scheduled date and time of opening will be marked as late, remain sealed, and will receive no further consideration for award. Bidders should allow enough time for mailing their bids to ensure delivery prior to the established cut-off time on the opening date and

time. The Agency will not be responsible for a late bid due to failure of the bidder to allow enough time for delivery of the bid.

7. To protect the integrity of the bidding process, bids shall not be prepared, completed, or altered on the premises of Agency. Any bid which is prepared, completed, or altered on the premises of Agency shall be immediately disqualified and receive no further consideration for award.
8. Bids, unless otherwise proven herein, are subject to applicable Public Records Law. Copies of bid responses must be requested and will be provided within a reasonable timeframe and at a fee established by Agency. To expedite and properly respond to such public records requests, a written request shall be submitted.
9. Any pre-bid questions or inquiries must be submitted in writing to the Agency and received no later than three (3) business days before the scheduled opening date. The Agency will not respond to any pre-bid questions or inquiries received later than three (3) business days before the scheduled opening date. Section 1: Intent

The purpose of this ITB is to establish pricing for one (1) 6000 PSI SCBA compressor, one (1) encapsulated multi-chamber fill station, capable of filling up to three (3) SCBA cylinders at one time, and four (4) 6000 psi, 510 cubic foot, ISO/UN (10 year retest) cascade bottles (hereafter referred to as SCBA filling system) to be installed at the Agency, located at 3650 Hoover Road, Grove City, Ohio 43123

Section 2: Free on Board (F.O.B.) Destination:

The net unit bid price shall include delivery charges, Free on Board (F.O.B.) to locations of system installation indicated in Section 1 of Requirements and Specifications.

Section 3: Delivery and Installation

Delivery and installation date(s) shall be established and agreed upon by both parties within a reasonable timeframe acceptable to the Agency.

3.1: Delivery Hours

All deliveries shall be made between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. EST, Monday through Friday unless special permission is granted by Agency to temporarily waive or adjust this requirement.

SCBA FILLING SYSTEM

-Bid Specifications-

A. General: These specifications are intended to describe the minimum performance and technical criteria of the SCBA FILLING SYSTEM which will allow Agency members to safely and efficiently fill depleted SCBA breathing air cylinders safely and efficiently according to all applicable NFPA standards. Proposals shall contain full information on the make, model and specifications of the breathing air compressor, charge station and cascade system as well as information on warranty and service considerations. The bid shall reflect total cost for all equipment and installation. All entities submitting bids are encouraged to conduct an on-site evaluation of proposed installation locations. Any additional costs incurred above and beyond the bid amount shall be the responsibility of the distributor/installer unless written agreement exists between the user and distributor/installer.

B. Scope:

The Agency is soliciting bids for the purchase of one (1) 6000 PSI SCBA compressor, one (1) encapsulated multi-chamber fill station capable of filling up to three (3) SCBA cylinders at a time, and four (4) 6000 psi, 510 cubic foot ISO/UN (10 year retest) cascade bottles.

The specifications are generic in nature and are not all inclusive. The specifications are the minimum standard that must be set to be considered for the Bid Contract award.

1. System Overview

1.1 This specification covers a commercially produced breathing air compressor, charge station, cascade system and its associated hardware and software. The breathing air compressor, charge station, cascade system and all applicable accessories delivered to these specifications shall be a standard commercial product that meets the requirements of these specifications. Exceptions to any of the line items are not desirable. Materials used in construction of the breathing air compressor, charge station, cascade system and associated accessories shall be new, unused and not less than the quality conforming to modern engineering and manufacturing practices. Materials shall be free of defects and suitable for the service intended.

2. Breathing Air Compressor

2.1 The breathing air compressor must connect and operate on our current electrical supply (220-volt AC, 1 phase, 60 Hz).

2.2 The breathing air compressor must fit and be easily operable in the area that is approximately 8.5 feet wide and 4 feet deep.

2.3 The breathing air compressor shall be capable of producing pressures of 6,000 psi.

2.4 The breathing air compressor will include air quality monitors and moisture indicators.

- 2.5 The breathing air compressor shall be supplied with a calibration kit for air quality monitors.
- 2.6 The breathing air compressor shall utilize a remote air intake.
- 2.7 The breathing air compressor shall be outfitted with an automatic drain system with muffler and reservoir.
- 2.8 The breathing air compressor shall be equipped with an automatic low oil shutdown with indicator.
- 2.9 The breathing air compressor shall be equipped with a stage gauge panel.
- 2.10 The breathing air compressor shall have an easily identifiable and operable emergency stop button.
- 2.11 The breathing air compressor shall be equipped with an operation time meter.
- 2.12 The breathing air compressor shall be equipped with an automatic high-temperature shutdown with indicator.
- 2.13 The breathing air compressor shall have an automatic control with digital readout panel.
- 2.14 The breathing air compressor shall meet all current NFPA 1989, CRN and CSA standards.
- 2.15 The breathing air compressor shall be equipped with a controller designed to monitor and control the compressor's operation. At minimum the controller shall monitor the compressor's discharge air temperature and oil level, be equipped with low oil and high temperature alarms, monitor for CO and alert when a high level is detected, alert for service and collect data of compressor usage and be user friendly.
- 2.16 The breathing air compressor with be turnkey operation. It shall be set up, installed and checked at the user's destination by the distributor/installer

3. Purification system

- 3.1 The purification system must be capable of purifying at least 37,000 SCF of breathing air.
- 3.2 The purification system shall deliver air that meets or exceeds all recognized respiratory standards as set by OSHA, CGA and NFPA.

4. Charge / Fill Station

- 4.1 The charge station shall be installed in the air/storage room of user's facility approximately 50 linear feet from the compressor.
- 4.2 The charge station shall be capable of charging two or more breathing air cylinders.
- 4.3 The charge stations shall come with a containment fragmentation shield that complies with all applicable, current NFPA standards.
- 4.4 The charge station shall be equipped with safety pressure gauges.
- 4.5 The charge station shall be equipped with a 4-bank cascade panel.

4.6 The charge station shall be complete with safety interlocks, safety gauges, charge and bleed valves and an adjustable pressure regulator.

4.7 The installation shall be turnkey and be set up, installed and checked out at the user's destination by the distributor/installer.

5. Cascade System

5.1 The cascade system shall meet all applicable, current ASME, DOT, TC, NFPA and CRN codes.

5.2 The cascade system shall be equipped with an overpressure safety device.

5.3 The cascade system shall come with all necessary cascade piping.

5.4 The cascade system shall be turnkey installation, it shall be set up, installed and checked out at the user's destination by the distributor/installer.

6. Training and Documentation

6.1 The user shall be provided with a full set of operations manuals.

6.2 The user shall receive training by the distributor on the operation and maintenance of the system.

7. Additional Options for Purchase

7.1 Manufacturer will provide a list of options available for purchase including, but not limited to extended warranties and preventive maintenance packages as available. These will be provided on pricing sheet below or separate sheet from base bid amount.
